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INSTRUCTIONS

A training exercise for beginners! Just be alert, be quick, be fast! Follow the units, but caution, catch the mistake. This game models pursuits for the police radio dispatcher. It's a fun way to learn.



TRAINERS

This game can be used in many ways. You can begin by having the students follow the pursuit — first they must study the map and surrounding area. During the pursuits, the nice officers will make mistakes (we know that never happens). It is up to the student to be sharp enough to discover the mistake and mark on the map where the mistake was made. On the DV, have the student locate the scene and daycare. You can find the mistake with them. Discuss the different scenes where an officer may get into a pursuit. Outline the methods used and if they are similar to your procedures. Go over the ways a pursuit can come in. Discuss what the dispatcher's duties are.

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Each of the 4 maps are to be copied for each student. The arrow indicates where the pursuit starts. Ask them to follow the roads as the officer states them. When the officer seems to make a mistake, ask them to circle where the mistake happened, but say nothing. When the pursuit ends, ask them mark the end location with a * and begin discussions. Allow each student to share what they experienced.

Scripts are provided for the trainer. The mistake is left a mystery for both the trainer and the student as the trainer will be more involved. You can then provide 'actual' pursuits and your procedures for review.

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ABOUT THE SCRIPTS

This game was created to practice taking police pursuits by providing simulated calls and a map for you to follow. A dispatcher's responsibility during a felony flight is to ensure the safety of the officer — this is accomplished by using certain procedures. The first procedure is called “echoing”, where the information is repeated back so all units can hear the location and direction of travel. The time is given as a validation. The dispatcher may also close the air and ensure there are back-up units enroute to assist when (or if) the officer stops the vehicle. Your job during this exercise is to gather all of the information and track the unit on a map. There is a catch — the officer will make one mistake during the pursuit and you must be able to identify where that was. Good luck, ready, begin.

SCRIPT #1

Sam One/ I'll be checking out a blue Chevy parked in the field here/ looks like no plate. We're at Lake Serene a few blocks off Shelby Road.

Sam One, occupied? Hard to tell, the windows are all fogged up here.

Ok SI, Lake Serene. Sam One, he just took off on me, we're northbound on Serene Way, 50+.

SI, in pursuit n/b Serene Way, 50+, Blue Chevy, SI confirm, plate?

No plate, one male aboard, he stepped on it when I walked up to the car. Blue Chevy Camero, he's all over the road.

All units, the air is closed, SI n/b Serene Way, blu Chev cam no plate. Unit to back?

***Sam Seven from Airport South.

Sam 7. 712 Sam One now headed to the speedway, still all over the road.

SI toward the speedway 712

***Sam 7, what's the description?

S7, blue camero, no plate, one male aboard Sam One, he just tossed something at Lake and Lincoln,

***Tom 11 can check, I'm in an unmarked, what side?

Check southwest at Lincoln and Lake. Sam One, west on the speedway, oops, just took the cut-off. Almost lost it there.

On the cut-off, erratic driver, blue Camero, 714 OK. we're on Beverly Park.

Direction?

East, White male Wearing a baseball cap, long black hair. There's a NRA sticker in the back window.

SCRIPT #1 *cont.*

S/b on Beverly Park, blue Camero w/m baseball cap, long black hair.

****Sam seven heading east from Gibson.

Sam One, passing Fairmount, northbound 112th, up to 70+

S1 n/b 112 from Beverly Park 70+

Heading west toward Holly

W/b from 112 toward Holly 716

Going into the Hollow Dale area. He just hit an occupied red Toyota at 17th, anybody that can check that out?

***Sam 7, I'm coming down 112

Sam One, we got three injured here, I'll be out. He's northbound across the field toward the highway —

Sam 7 turn around, I think he's trying for the highway.

Received three injuries, aid enroute at 717

Sam 7 did you copy, Sam 1 out with the accident, the suspect should come out on the highway from Hollowdale?

***Sam 7, turning around now.

All units, Sam 1 out with an accident, the suspect vehicle in the pursuit is now an injury hit and run. A blue Camero, occupied by one WM, baseball cap, long dark hair. Last two ago headed toward the highway from Hollow Dale, excessive speeds, erratic driving. 718

Sam One, advise if you can give me any more on that description.

SCRIPT #2

264, I'm in pursuit of a motorcycle, plate Paul 659. s/b Winesap at Meridian Pl.

264 in pursuit, s/b Winesap at meridian 2310.

264 at the cemetery, looks like a green & white dirt bike with number 14 on the back. Two kids with black ski jackets. Follow going into the cemetery.

264 in pursuit of a green white dirt bike, two aboard in the cemetery.

264, I've lost em up the pipeline westbound

Lost in the pipeline westbound at 2312.

I'm at the cul-de-sac. We can hear em approaching. I've got em. we're headed left on 185th. Only one aboard now.

K91 has one aboard, 185th & 9th. s/b Larch Way. 263 coming up Filbert

Jerry, they're coming right at you.

I don't see em.

Must have turned west. I lost em.

K9 One, what was their last direction, speed?

I thought they turned east on Filbert from Larch, he was about 40 pulling out of the cul-de-sac.

263, I have him, We're southbound Cypress, 50 mph.

263 s/b Cypress, 50 green white dirt bike one aboard. 263 westbound 20th

263 w/b 20th

263 2/b 20th from Filbert?

263 affirmative, toward 192nd. Now eastbound 192 — he's down at 18th.

263 stopped, mc down 192 and 18th.

SCRIPT #3

King Two?

Yeah, I have a fail to yield here, she's only going about 20 but I've been with her about a mile, either she's deaf or blind. White Cadillac, Union-Paul-John 444.

Location?

Oh yeah — We're creeping along Loganberry Lane from the Golf Course.

King Two, following a Whi Cadi UPJ 444 on Loganberry from the Golf Course, female aboard.

King 2 she sees me, she doesn't want to stop. OK, we're still on 18th, we've picked up the pace to 30. I'll just stay with her.

Received 1230 Hours (pause)

King 2 your Status?

Siren now.....

We're still being ignored, heading onto Dakota Way , Oops there she goes, she's put the foot to the pedal. I'm in pursuit, she's really pulling out.

King Two in pursuit northbound Dakota Way from 100th White Cadillac OJP444.

King Two northbound Holly.

n/b Holly 1232.

King Two looks like we have another occupant, male in the passenger seat — just popped up. Female driver, white hair, w/b 100th.

King Two w/b 100 from Holly. Your plate returns to a 92 Cadillac Seville, Connie Johnson, 10320 Howard Av this city.

SCRIPT #3 *cont.*

Approaching Evergreen. She has her blinker on to go southbound.

Approaching Evergreen. Speed? 50, 40, 30...She's s/b evergreen, just stepped on it again.

Southbound Evergreen from 100th. Do we have any units in the area?

(no answer)

King Two, 105th SW. She's slowing down, pulling up at 1st Pl West off of 104th. We'll be out at I0320 1st Pl West.

King Two, you don't have a back up yet. King Two has the Vehicle stopped, 10320 1st Pl West, is there a unit to back?

***Adam 12.

Adam 12 to back, from where.

***Adam 12, I'm with em, no problem. Apparently a few too many toddies at the Golf Course luncheon.

SCRIPT #4

All Units attempt to locate, suspect in a domestic assault. Mike Trenton, WM, 604, blonde balding, driving a red Chevy Blazer, unknown plate. Subject assaulted his ex-wife in her home at 6510 NE 128th PI within the last 30. Trenton has threatened to "shoot any police officer who stops him" and may be enroute to the daycare at 7322 141 Av NE to take his two children. Trenton has been drinking, unknown if he has a gun. Again, that's a WM blonde balding in a red Chevy Blazer, We're trying to get the plate from DOL. 22 Copy?

22 Copy.

24 Copy?

24.

22, I'll have a maroon colored Blazer, occupied at the light Snyder's Corner, plate 79833, tinted windows, can't see the driver yet.

79833, Snyder's Corner.

22, that vehicle returns to Record Stationary, this city — an 82 Chev Blazer. 22, I'll be stopping him here shortly.

Unit to back 22, Snyder's corner.

Sirens.

22, I'm in pursuit northbound 132nd, maroon Blazer.

22 in pursuit n/b 132 from NE 70th.

Approaching 65th.

Correction, southbound 132 approaching 65th, possible suspect in DV and threats to police. Unit to back?

**24, where is he?

SCRIPT #4 *cont.*

22, I'm now n/b 65th coming up to a dead end. In the area of Benjamin Franklin.

**24 copy, is this Trenton?

22, I would suppose, the Blazer is registered to some company, do you know where he works?

**You have a red blazer?

Yeah, radio, he's, we took a left at the dead end heading toward Bridlewood Circle, I can't see any signs in here.

22 last location was 65th approaching 126, did you turn left at 65th.

Affirmative. We're at 60th taking a right.

Northbound 60th from 126th, speed?

50 right now, he's slowing down.

24, your location?

**24, I'm at ..I'm out about 2 — isn't there someone closer?

22, he's parked and not moving. I'll wait.

22, what's your exact location?

We're at the entrance to Bridle Trail off 60th, about 13000 block.
